I will not be able to participate in public comments during the June 3, 2024, regular OCPS School Board meeting due to travel plans. I wish to express my support for the OCPS School Board decision to discontinue membership in the Virginia School Board Association (VSBA).

School board members are certainly within their remit to determine if the ~ \$12,000 annual cost for VSBA membership is commensurate with benefits received back to OCPS.

In your August 23, 2023, Orange County Candidate Showcase responses, you proclaimed your <u>individual</u> support for encouraging the Orange County School Board becoming a "Virginia School Board Association Master Board.", However, as we now know, the majority of the Orange County School Board members oppose VSBA membership – and for valid reasons.

- While the VSBA purports to be non-partisan, it has a history of supporting issues contrary to the values of the majority of Orange County voters, to wit:
